Students

For some guidance on how to use your personal device to collaborate, communicate, research, and think creatively and critically:

- Review the BYOD permission form and Acceptable Use Agreement with your parents and ask for their signature
- Follow the Acceptable Use Policy when using your device
- Respect “no use” areas
- Identify ways in which you can use your personal device for learning and share with your teachers and parents
- Use your device for class-related purposes with teacher permission
- Let your teacher easily see your screen, and stay on task
- Keep your device secure at all times to avoid theft or damage. Don’t loan it to anyone
- Charge your device at home
- Extend your own learning after completing your classroom assignments (with teacher permission)
- Use the PWCS Guest Network WiFi configuration to conserve your battery and increase speed
- Troubleshoot your own device
